# City Cadet, 17 Is Winner Of Air Trophy

Leho Proos, 17, a Montreal air cadet, has won the W. F. Tudhope (Memorial Trophy in a contest open to newly-licensed pilots who belong to the Royal Canadian Flying Clubs.

Sgt. Proos, 6129 Trans island avenue, is a member of 588 Canadian Air Cadet Squadron and trained under an RCAF flying scholarship in July. He obtained top marks (92 per cent) in the trophy competition.

The trophy was presented by the late Maj. J. H. Tudhope in memory of his son, who died in the Battle of Britain.

Sgt. Proos was among 14 competitors from 12 flying clubs across the country. All were **required** to be under 19 years old and to have obtained over 80 **per cent** in written Department of Transport exams.

The trophy will be presented at the 30th annual meeting of the flying club association in Montreal Feb. 17.
