

I.A.M. LODGE 712 "PROFICIENCY TROPHY"

The Lodge 712 Proficiency Trophy is awarded annually to the most proficient first year cadet within the Canadair Squadrons. In order to establish continuity in the selection of cadet nominees by the respective Commanding Officers, and for the Civilian Committee members delegated to conduct the short interviews and determine the winning cadet, the following prerequisites and guidelines are recommended_-

1. PREREQUISITES

- a) That the cadet nominated shall be a first year cadet as defined by the Air Cadet League of Canada (i.e.) a cadet who has become a member of a squadron during the current air cadet training year which coincides with the normal educational school year (1 Sept. to 31 Aug)
- b) That the cadet nominated shall have been of legal age on the date of enrollment with the squadron.
- c) That the cadet nominee shall have been following the Junior Level Training Programme.
- d) That the cadet should be capable of responding to questions within the boundaries of the training covered to date, particularly basic general knowledge of the Air Cadet League of Canada Organization and a basic knowledge of the Canadian Forces regarding Ranks, Basic Drill up to Flight Drill Standard, and the fundamental responsibilities of a Civilian Committee and the Canadian Forces.
- e) That the Commanding Officer shall prepare a short narrative on the cadet nominee and make available the cadets' squadron file, including information on the training completed to date.
- f) That the cadet shall be in uniform at the compulsory interview.

2. GUIDELINES

- a) That the interview board be composed of three delegated members of the Civilian Committee.
- b) That the nominated cadets be interviewed on a normal squadron, evening parade as previously determined by the Civilian Committee and the respective Commanding Officers.

2. GUIDELINES (Cont 'd)

- c) That the result determined by the members of the interviewing board shall remain confidential until the presentation at the current Annual Inspection.
- d) That any amendments to the pre-requisites or guidelines shall be determined by the Civilian Committee.
